## The Church of Thyatira

### Group Discussion Questions

1. Only once in the book of Revelation does Jesus introduce himself as the “Son of God.” Why did he use this phrase with Thyatira?
2. Thyatira was a small, working person’s town, with many trade guilds. The city was basically secular, with no focus on any particular religion. What special challenges does a small town like Gulf Breeze face in our time?
3. The church at Pergamum was tolerating compromise. The church at Thyatira was tolerating immortality. What actions can we take to keep ourselves pure, and prevent tolerating the immortality that is so prevalent in the world around us?
4. How can we encourage one another within the body, including our leaders in Pastoral ministry, to remain pure in our walk with the Lord? What actions can we take to stay accountable in this area of purity?
5. The character of the church of Thyatira was commended for its love, faith, service, and patient endurance. Discuss what each of these character traits mean and how they can be seen in the church today. What do these traits tell you about the church, then and now.
6. If there were a section of Revelation 2 written to our church at Coastline Calvary Chapel Gulf Breeze, what do you think we would be praised for? Accused of? Admonished to do?
