Connect Group Sermon-Based Questions Meetings February 12th – 18th Revelation 20, 21 and 22

 Warren Wiersbe mentions the word "utopia," in his commentary on Revelation 20:1-6, in conjunction with the millennial reign of Christ. Describe a world that would, to you, be a utopia. What is your reaction to the fact that even in a perfect environment, not everyone will honor God?

Quote from Pastor Neil from the following week: "A perfect environment cannot produce a perfect heart."

- 2. Revelation 20:6 reads that after the first resurrection, those who belong to Christ "will be priests of God and of Christ and will reign with Him for a thousand years." In light of this coming age, what should our priorities and goals look like, as Christ lives in us now?
- 3. Most of us have had at least one experience where we especially felt the presence of God. Describe what it would be like to live in a place described in Revelation 21 by the words, "God's home is now among His people! He will live with them, and they will be His people. God Himself will be with them."

Are the things Jesus revealed about Himself in the book of Revelation literal or symbolic? Explain your answer.
