John 4:1-10

1. In John chapter 1, verse 4, we're told Jesus, "had to go through Samaria on the way." Where is Jesus calling you that you may not want to or feel equipped to go? How does this story give you confidence to follow the Lord's leading into difficult or awkward places? Make a commitment today to trust God to lead you as you go where ever He's calling you.

"God has given all things into His hands." This gives us confidence! As David said, "The Lord is **MY** shepherd." When we understand Jesus is Lord and Savior, we trust and follow him with abandon. Following Christ means we have to lay something down.

2. Describe a time in your life when God met you in a personal struggle and obviously made personal contact with you? How did you respond.

3. In 1 John 5:20, John describes Jesus as the gift and the giver. How should this effect your prayer life?
